How it came to be



May 2007

Luc Somers from Belgium cycles from Accra to Kpando and visits the schools of Kpando Agbenoxoe and Fesi. The P.E. teachers of local schools ask him to help to organize sports activities.



July 2008

Luc Somers returns to Kpando with 4 friends. They organize sports activities at the schools of Agbenoxoe and Fesi. Back in Belgium, they also raised funds to start the renovation of R.C. primary school at Dafor.



October 2008

Luc Somers, Lode Vanholder, and Emmelie Eyllenbosch start Support Ghana organization (NGO) in Belgium. That way, they can raise funds to support the development of Kpando.



2009-2014

Every year, Support Ghana brings more than 20 visitors from Belgium to Kpando. They continue to renovate school buildings, help to organize sports activities, and contribute to the health care system. Since 2011 the organization also started to help students with the payment of their school fees.



June 2015

Several Ghanaian students get inspired by the actions of Support Ghana and they decide to start a local NGO named **Emo Foundation**. From now on, the Belgian and Ghanaian organizations will work together closely as Support Ghana will be the main source of fundings.
